■ The Paulownia hardwood tree is already well known and popular in China for its robustness, reliable quality and rapid growth. The basic characteristics of the tree are essentially as follows:

- Very high flash point (420 degrees C.)
- Highly stable, thus storm resistant
- Frost resistant to -24 degrees Celsius

Thus, in contrast to many other tree species such as the German oak (with a flash point of only 270 degrees C.), these positive characteristics mean the tree
